If your 2025 BAH rate is lower than your current rate, you are Rate Protected and will continue paying the higher rate. Residents stationed outside Fort Leavenworth must submit their most recent orders and mid-month January 2025 LES to the Community Management Office. Market Rate Village residents paying flat-rate rent are not impacted by the BAH adjustment unless their BAH is below the flat rate. However, Market Rate rent amounts will adjust at lease renewal.

Allotments:

No action needed for Fort Leavenworth duty station. Provide required documents if stationed elsewhere.

Self-Set Payments via ActiveBuilding, ACH, or Credit Card:

Adjust payment amounts before your due date or pay any difference by February 5, 2025.

Payments Through Your Bank:

Update payment amounts with your financial institution for the February 1, 2025, rent payment.

Residents outside Fort Leavenworth must email or drop off their mid-month January 2025 LES, including their address and phone number, to the Community Management Office.

Trash Collection

Snow Removal

Wallace will initially clear a single lane on all streets. Residents are responsible for shoveling around their vehicles and personal sidewalks. If conditions permit, a second pass will be made to clear a two-lane road; however, this may not occur if vehicles are parked on the street. Sidewalks will be addressed once the streets are cleared. Please be patient as we work to clear your street. Snow removal may take some time, but we are committed to keeping the community safe and accessible.

Preventative Maintenance (PM)

During the PMs a maintenance technician will check the entire home for LHS issues (Life, Health, Safety). As part of the process, they will clean the fridge cooling coils, clean the HVAC boot return, as well as replace the HVAC filter, and check all locks and plumbing.

Keep an eye on your emails for your scheduled village testing days. You will also see a service request in Active Building and receive a door hanger on your door.

Taco Tuesday Recap


