Please be advised that Waste Management is no longer providing bulk trash pickup. If you have items that do not fit in your regular trash or recycle receptacles, you may utilize one of the following alternative disposal options:

- On-post Recycle Center located on Warehouse Road
- Leavenworth County Solid Waste Transfer Station located at 24967 136th St, Lansing, KS 66043 (Access by turning east off Highway 7, then onto Gilman Road)
- City Union Mission for gently used household items. Check your email the first week of the month to complete the Google Form for Union City Mission pickups the 2nd Saturday of every month.

Radon Testing

Testing is being completed by Village. Door hangers will be delivered to the house a week before testing. Email blasts will continue to assist in communicating the testing.

The contractor, Midwest Radon, will be accompanied by an FLFHC Maintenance Technician to deploy the test and retrieve the test two days later.

The work order for the testing will remain open, pending results, which are normally received 10 business days after the test is collected.

After receiving the test results, they are input into the work order notes and the work order will be closed if the results are within the acceptable range.

Houses with high results will be scheduled for mitigation; the test work order will be left open until the mitigation work order is created and scheduled.

This testing is mandatory for all units that have not been tested within the last two years.
